Warrook Cattle Farm

Experience real country living on a working farm, handle animals and see how a farming family lives. Visit a historic farmhouse to enjoy old fashioned hospitality before starting your hands-on farm tour. Have fun feeding baby animals, see how cows are milked, enjoy a sheep shearing demonstration, watch working dogs round up sheep and stock whip cracking.



Penguin Parade: See Australia's world famous penguin parade from the **Penguins Plus** Viewing Platform. 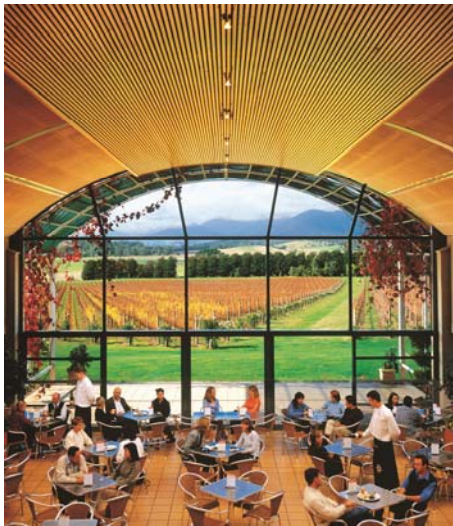
