A coastal town with delightful restaurants & cafes and crystal clear blue water, indeed is a great getaway.

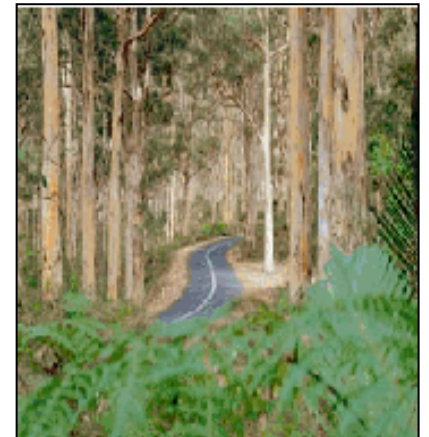
Mandurah Canal & Estuary Cruise

Mammoth Cave - This awe inspiring limestone cave is a natural time capsule. Home to ancient fossil remains of extinct animals with an array of formations. Truly remarkable with nature's forces at its best

FREMANTLE

Monument Hill - The main memorial at 14m in height constructed from Donnybrook stone, was built in 1928 to commemorate the 59,330 Australians killed or posted as missing in action in WW1.

The Round House - The oldest remaining building in Western Australia. It was built as a gaol and was the first permanent building in the colony.

Fishing Boat Harbour - A thriving community of restaurants and cafes, situated on the bay and harbour. The place for all the best mouthwatering food the ocean has to offer.
