VIENNA

The capital of Austria situated on the banks of the Danube. Known as the city of art and culture, Vienna has been synonymous with music for centuries, and home to Mozart and Beethoven. City tours features the Town Hall, famous Ring Boulevard with its beautiful monuments, Parliament, Belvedere Garden and stop for a stroll in Heroes' Square to view the Hofburg. The highlight would be visit to the majestic Schonbrunn Palace and Garden, former summer residence of the Hasburg family.



BUDAPEST

Guided city tour of this Hungarian capital covers sights of the Parliament building, the Royal Castle, the 13th century Matthias Coronation Church, Heroes Square and enjoys panoramic views or the citadel at Mount Gellery. Entrance to Fisherman's Bastion is included to enjoy more spectacular views from its lacy look-out towers.

PRAGUE

The capital and largest city of the Czech Republic and has been included in the UNESCO list of World Heritage Sites. Prague Castle is the largest ancient castle in the world. City tours include Prague Castle and landmarks such as the old Town Hall with the Astronomical clock, Charles Bridge which links the old Town and St.Vitus Cathedral. There will be ample time to immerse yourselves with Bohemian culture including shopping for its famed crystal products at your leisure.

BRNO

Second largest city in Czech Republic. The architectural legacy from the past is still present today. The spires of the churches, together with the towers and walls of Spilberk Castle, which dates back to the 13th century, help form The unmistakable profile of the city.

KRAKOW

Krakow, is one of the largest and oldest cities in Poland. For centuries Krakow was the capital of Poland. Famous landmarks include the Main Market Square and the Sukiennice Cloth Hall, the Wawel Castle. In 1978, UNESCO added Kraków's historic centre, which includes the Old Town and the Wawel Castle to the list of World Heritage Sites.

Day 2 Arrival Vienna (D)

- City tour includes entrance to Schonbrunn Palace and Hofburg Palace.

Day 3 Vienna/ Budapest (B/L/D)

- Guided tour of Budapest – visit include Heroes Square, Parliament, Royal Castle, St Gellert Hill.

Day 4 Budapest/ Banska Bystrica / Krakow (B/L/D)

- Depart for Krakow.
- Lunch at Banska Bystrica.

Day 5 Krakow/ Wieliczka/ Krakow (B/L/D)

- Entrance to Wawel Castle, The Hall of Cloths Stalls, and Salt Mine.
- Krakow city tour include Old Town, Main Market Square, Czartoryski Museum.

Day 6 Krakow/ Brno/ Prague (B/L/D)

- Depart for Brno.
- After lunch, visit Spielberg Castle.
- Continue journey to Prague.

Day 7 Prague (B/L/D)

- City tours include entrance to Prague Castle. Old Royal Palace including Vladislav, Golden Lane and Daliborka Tower, Hall, Powder Tower, St Georges Basilica.

Day 8 Prague/ Vienna (B/L)

- Depart for Vienna.
- After lunch, free at own leisure for shopping.

Day 9 Vienna /Depart home (B)

- After breakfast, transfer to airport for flight home.

Day 10 Arrival home
