Madrid

The capital of Spain since 1562, is located on the geographic center of the Iberian Peninsula. Madrid is a city of great monuments. Madrid is not just a cultural destination. Our tour of Madrid covers Grand Via, the "Bukit Bintang" of Madrid, Puerta Del Sol junction, the lovely Plaza de Espana Garden Park, Prado Museum grounds and entrance into the Royal Palace and the Military Museum. Complete the day with a traditional Paella seafood dinner.

Toledo

Toledo is a fortified city built on a hill overlooking the Tagus River and is without a doubt one of the densest monumental cities in the world. Unique because of its Arab, Jewish and Christian heritage.

Granada

A key Andalusian city standing at the foot of Spain's highest mountain range, Sierra Nevada. Our tour includes the focal point of Granada - the magnificent Alhambra, a fortress, palace and mini city all in one, built so majestically on a hill overlooking the city and its adjacent Generalife, a summer palace with impressive fountains and gardens.

Casablanca - is a city in western Morocco, located on the Atlantic Ocean. It is the capital of the Greater Casablanca region. Casablanca is the leading city hosting headquarters and main industrial facilities for the leading Moroccan and international companies based in Morocco. Casablanca's icon is state of the art and a relatively new addition to the city's landscape. Opened in 1993 to commemorate the former king's 60th birthday the Hassan II Mosque has a retractable roof and a heated floor. Designed by French architect is the third largest mosque in the world. The interior can hold up to 25,000 worshippers.

Seville

Capital of Andalusia and of Carmen, of Don Juan and Figaro fame. The popular Giralda of Seville is the old minaret of the twelfth century Almohad mosque, transformed into the bell tower of the Cathedral.

Cordoba

Once a key capital of the Roman Empire as well as the capital of the Moorish kingdom of El-Andalus.

DAY 02 Madrid /Toledo/Granada (B/L/D)

- After breakfast, Madrid city tour include visit to Royal Palace, also called Palacio de Oriente and view of Plaza Espana.
- After lunch, Toledo city tour include entrance to Victoria Macho Museum.
- Coach to Granada(4hrs).

DAY 03 Granada/ Cordoba (B/L/D)

- Granada city tour include visit to Alhambra Palace and Generalife.
- After lunch, transfer to Cordoba (3hrs).

DAY 04 Cordoba/Seville (B/L/D)

- Cordoba city tours include entrance to Mezquita.
- After lunch, transfer to Seville (2hrs).
- Seville city tour include Giralda Tower and Cathedral.

DAY 05 Seville /Algeciras/Tangier (B/L/D)

- Transfer to Algeciras (2.5hrs).
- After lunch, by Ferry crossing from Algeciras to Tangiers, A city of northern Morocco.

DAY 06 Tangiers /Fez (B/L/D)

- By coach to Fez (5hrs)
- Fez city tour.

DAY 07 Fez /Beni Mellal /Marrakech (B/L/D)

- After breakfast, leave to Beni Mellal, capital of the fertile plain of Tadla (4hrs).
- After lunch, continue to Marrakech.

DAY 08 Marrakech / Casablanca (B/L/D)

- Marrakech city tours include visit Bahia Palace, The Kouba Ba'adyin and The Djemaa El Fna Square.
- After dinner, transfer to Casablanca (3.5hrs).

DAY 09 Casablanca / Departure (B)

- Casablanca city tours include visit The Old Madina, Hassan II Mosque, King Mohammed Square V and Bazaar.
