### THEME PARKS

**Yongin Everland** - one of the most popular amusement park in Korea attached with a zoo and botanical garden. It contains three distinct themes, which are Festival World, Caribbean Bay, and Speedway. The fairyland-like Festival World hosts flower festivals every season, where millions of flowers show off their remarkable colors.

**MBC Drama Filming Studio** – First TV drama theme park in Korea. The main filming location of Daejanggeum (Jewel in The Palace). Filled with events and fun programs you can get an inside look at the sets or be immersed in the reproduced drama series. Explore the drama props, royal dishes and costumes created for the scenes.

### JEJU ISLAND

Jeju is a volcanic island formed by activity from the 3rd Cenozoic period to the 4th period, 2 million years ago. It's assumed that Jeju of today was formed by the repeated change of state, being a part of continent and an island brought by volcanic activities, sea level changes from glaciation and crustal activity.



### SEOUL

- **Kyongbok Palace:** Built in 1394 during the Joseon Dynasty, Cheong Wa Dae.
- **Presidential Blue House:** This is the presidential residence of the Republic of Korea.
- **Folklore Museum-** Located within the grounds of Kyongbok Palace. Nine exhibition rooms, a laboratory, folk craft room, social culture and a special display room, and its many exhibits and displays show all facets of the traditional Korean lifestyle.
- **Namsan Hanok Village** – Korean Traditional House with Culture.

Ginseng centre, Amethyst factory, Insa Dong, Myungdong and Tap Dong Underground shopping Mall in Jeju.
