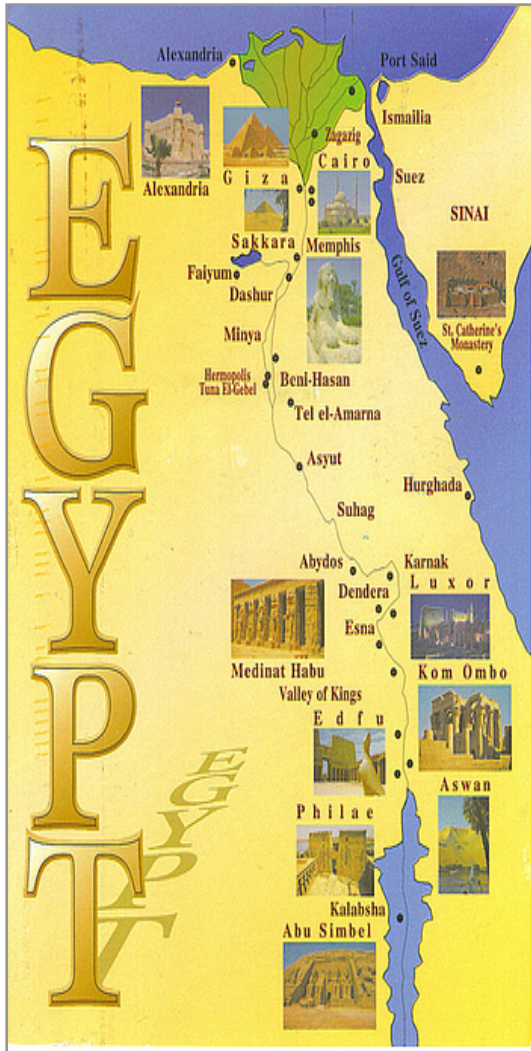

COMPREHENSIVE SIGHTS & ACTIVITIES



CAIRO – The glorious capital of Egypt, the city of the Thousand Minarets and the Melting Pot of Ancient and Modern Egyptian Civilizations.

- **THE EGYPTIAN MUSEUM:** Contains the largest & finest collection Pharaonic antiquities in the world.
- **THE PYRAMIDS OF GIZA:** The only surviving of Seven Wonders of the Ancient World.
- **THE SPHINX:** A legendary statue for it has the body of lion and the face of a man Also known as the “father of fear”.
- **SAKKARA:** is one section of the great necropolis of Memphis.
- **CITADEL:** located on a spur of limestone that had been detached from its parent Moqattam Hills by quarrying. It is one of the world’s greatest monuments to medieval warfare, as well as a highly visible landmark on Cairo’s eastern skyline.
- **KHAN EI KHALILI:** One of the oldest & biggest bazaars in the Middle East. Good offer for brassware, copper, perfumes and leather.

ALEXANDRIA - The second largest city in Egypt, It has an atmosphere that is more Mediterranean than Middle Eastern and its ambiance and cultural heritage distance it from the rest of the country.

- **POMPEY’S PILLAR:** The largest memorial column in Egypt.
- **CATACOMBS OF KOMASH-SHOUGAFA:** The Catacombs (meaning underground tunnels) lie in the district of Karmouz to the east of Alexandria. The area was called Kom El-Shouqafa or a pile of shards.
- **MONTAZAH PALACE:** Used to be the summer home of the Egyptian royal family.
- **FORT QAITBEY:** Located on the original site of the lighthouse of pharos that was one of the original 7 wonders.

ABU SIMBEL - was saved from the rising waters of Lake Nasser, growing behind the Aswan Dam, in a massive archaeological rescue plan sponsored by **UNESCO** in the 1960s. The complex of temples dedicated to the Pharaoh Ramesses II “the Great” remains an evocative and unforgettable destination.

ASWAN – Situated down river from the First Nile Cataract, it is the southernmost city.

- **TEMPLE OF KOM OMBO:** The temple known as Komombo is actually two temple consisting of a Temple to Sobek and Temple of Haroeris.
- **HIGH DAM:** The world famous High Dam was an engineering miracle when it was built in the 1960s.
- **TEMPLE OF PHILAE:** The Island of Philae was an important place of pilgrimage for worshippers until long into the Christian era.

EDFU – Stands beside the Nile almost exactly half-way between Luxor and Aswan.

- **TEMPLE OF HORUS:** This temple is dedicated to the Falcon Horus.

LUXOR – Modern Luxor grew on the ruins of Thebes, once the capital of ancient Egypt’s New Kingdom (1550-1069BC).

- **VALLEY OF THE KINGS:** Where the opened tomb of King Tutankhamen lies.
- **HATSEPSUT TEMPLE:** It was built for the great queen Hatshepsut (18th century) to commemorate her achievements.
- **COLOSSI OF MEMNON:** Amenhotep III (18th Dynasty) built a mortuary temple in Thebes that was guarded by two gigantic statues on the outer gates.

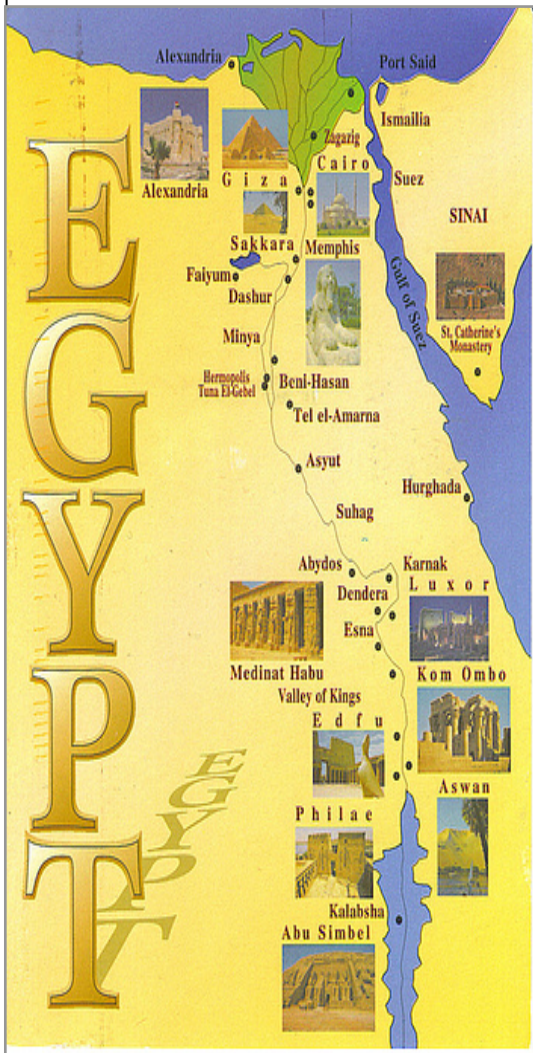

開羅/亞歷山大/亞斯旺/阿布辛貝神廟/康蒙波/艾得夫/盧克索/尼羅河游輪

【開羅】

古埃及人稱開羅為“城市之母”，阿拉伯人把開羅叫做“卡海勒”，意為征服者或勝利者。開羅也是阿拉伯聯盟總部所在地。

- **埃及博物館**：是世界上最著完整、規模最大的古埃及文物博物館。
- **吉薩金字塔群**：世界七大奇蹟之一。埃及金字塔是至今最大的建築群之一，成為了古埃及文明最有影響力和持久的象徵之一。
- **獅身人面像**：形象上是一具有著人頭的臥姿獅子。它可能是世上最古老和最巨大的雕像。其“人面”是法老哈夫的形象，獅身代表威嚴。
- **塞加拉**：在埃及古王國之後仍然是貴族的長眠之地。
- **薩拉赫丁堡壘**：坐落在一座經過挖掘後已和莫克坦山分開了的石灰石上。它是世上有關中世紀戰爭最偉大的紀念碑之一，同時也是開羅的東部地平線的一個不容錯過的標地。
- **汗哈利利傳統市場**：是中东地區最大的民間傳統手工藝市場，更是了解埃及乃至中东阿拉伯文化、風俗的櫥窗。在此您可以討價還價，自由選購埃及特色工藝品。

【亞歷山大】

又稱之為“埃及新娘”，是埃及第二大城市。這地方擁有濃厚的地中海區的文化，使其氣氛和文化遗产與埃及的其他地方有所差距。

- **龐培柱**：又稱騎士之柱，此支柱乃是埃及最大的紀念柱。
- **孔索加法地下墓穴**：這像迷宮似的地下地道坐落在亞歷山大成的東邊。
- **蒙塔扎夏宮**：曾經是古埃及皇族的避暑勝地。
- **龐貝城**：坐落在已毀的曾經是七大奇蹟之一的法羅斯燈塔的位置。

【阿布辛貝神廟】

是拉美西斯二世用以炫耀他的偉大所建的神殿，至今仍是令人難忘的古蹟。1960年代為免神廟被上升的納賽爾河水淹沒，聯合國把神廟切割後，再依原貌于現在的所在地重建。

【亞斯旺】

坐落在第一個尼羅河大瀑布下游處。是埃及最南部的城市。

- **康蒙波雙神殿**：謂之雙神殿是因為它由南北兩殿拼成，分別祭祀鱷魚神（索貝克神）和老鷹神（荷魯茲神）。
- **阿斯旺高壩**：建設於1960年，主要是需要對洪水加以控制，保護農田和棉田而設立。是轰动一时的建設。
- **菲萊神廟**：是埃及唯一需要乘船涉水才能到達的神廟。是埃及現存最完好的神廟之一。

【艾得夫】

位於阿斯旺及樂蜀之間，是遊覽樂蜀——阿斯旺黃金線路的必經之地。

- **荷魯斯神廟**：裡面供奉著天空之神荷魯斯。因為當尼羅河泛濫時會將整座神殿淹沒深藏土中，使得它成為目前保存狀態最好的神廟。

【盧克索】

從埃及首都開羅，上溯尼羅河的650公里。盧克索是古代都市底比的所在地。

- **帝王谷**：於帝王谷的墓幾乎都被掠奪殆盡，但陵墓內的各種浮雕和彩繪，仍保存完整，極有觀賞價值。
- **哈特謝卜舒特女王神殿**：哈特謝卜舒特女王是人類有史以來第一位女王，神殿高3層，方方正正，感覺相當奇怪。
- **曼農巨像**：阿曼霍特普三世最著名的雕像就是位於路克索的那兩個曼農巨像。他們都是用一整塊石英石刻成的。
