

3天2夜 吳哥窟探索之旅

暹粒 (CAW)



【行程特色】

- **吳哥窟** - 世界七大奇迹之一，具有东盟 UNESCO 魅力城市的美称，绝对不容错过。
- 观赏传统舞蹈：天女舞蹈。
- 赞叹大自然的美妙：洞里萨湖村的生活体验。

包罗万象的旅游景点

柬埔寨文化村庄- 占地 210,000 平方公尺。柬埔寨文化村庄里的那闻名历史的建筑物集合了当地的族群民风及其他各种族的地方风俗和特色。那里有着 11 个独特并各具特色的村庄。它们带出 19 个不同种族的文化遗产与特征。

- **村庄**- 高棉村庄里有着许多类型房，都是高棉人（柬埔寨人）的主要房子模式。高棉人的生活方式简单，他们以耕种田、制作生棕榈糖、存贮米粮、雕刻工作、编织工作、制作陶泥品、捕鱼及玩些道地的小玩意过生活。
- **蜡像博物馆**- 在柬埔寨文化村庄的两间蜡像博物馆都摆设着柬埔寨从历史世纪直到现今的名人及文化，如国王、王后、军人、大使、修士、少数族裔、电影明星、天女舞蹈及建造吴哥窟寺庙的历史。除此，柬埔寨人在吴哥帝国时代的生活方式以及惊世的人物图像与各式的漆画工程艺术都能在蜡像博物馆里看得到。
- **袖珍艺术**- 聚集了所有闻名历史的袖珍艺术，如著名的建筑物与建筑结构、前首都乌登、王宫、国家博物馆、钟型塔、中央市场、12 世纪的 Kompong Kdey 桥、16 世纪的凝视佛陀、独立纪念碑等的模型。

【暹粒】

位于世界遗产吴哥窟 7 公里和洞里萨湖 12 公里处的是柬埔寨既金边以外又一主要城市暹粒。城中有一条河横穿而过。暹粒城本身并不十分繁华，以国际标准来说比较荒芜，有“酣睡的洞穴”之称。

● **吳哥窟**：是供奉印度神毗湿奴（Vishnu）的寺庙，为苏利拔摩二世所建。吴哥窟主体建筑在一个石基上，分为 3 层，约有 20 层楼高。精美浮雕长廊，刻画印度和佛教以及诸神教义的神圣色彩。于 1992 年 UNESCO 正式宣告吴哥窟为世界伟大建筑遗产之一。

● **大吳哥**：大吳哥即是吳哥城，是 1181 年至 1219 年間在位的加亞華曼七世（ayavarman VII）所建，這是一座被長達 12 公里的護城河所包圍的大型古城。整個建築格局上，除了寬闊的護城河外，還有完整的城牆、進城橋樑和五座城門。吳哥城的五座城門分別是東門、西門、南門、北門及勝利之門。

✓ **巴戎廟**：由 49 座代表當年版圖有 49 個諸侯領土，每一座 3 公尺高的塔上都刻著“四面佛陀”加亞巴爾曼七世的微笑面容，俗稱“高棉的微笑”，他以這些面孔象徵至高無上的王權，並用以反映宇宙的節奏律動，軒昂的眉宇、中穩的鼻樑、熱情的厚唇，慈祥的氣質。

✓ **門象台**：由 54 座古塔所架構而成，周圍笑容可掬的四面神，造就聞名於世的高棉微笑；置身在迦雅巴曼七世。

✓ **癲王台**：內有古時判官及麻瘋王雕刻建築。現在癲王台上的雕像是複製品，東國已將原來的雕像放在金邊的博物館裡。



【行程】

第 1 天 飛往暹粒-柬埔寨（午/晚）

- 抵达暹粒。
- 探索柬埔寨水上文化村。这包括了一览传统的柬埔寨婚礼仪式、参观蜡像博物馆、少数民族部落及欣赏土风舞。
- 在暹粒的老市场购物并一览巴肯山欣赏迷人的夕阳景致。
- 下榻酒店。

第 2 天 暹粒（早/午/晚）

- 游览吴哥城南门，观赏巴戎廟、班巴布万庙、門象台、皇宫以及癲王台。
- 到吴哥窟一游。
- 晚餐有传统舞蹈助兴 ~ 天女舞蹈。

第 3 天 暹粒/ 返回家园（早）

- 早餐过后，探索坐落在洞里萨湖的柬埔寨水上村。
- 参观 Les Artisan 金边艺术中心-专卖手工工艺品的市集。
- 送往机场，乘搭班机，返回家园。

- Indulge in the mystical **Angkor Wat**, the largest religious monument in the world and a **UNESCO** World Heritage Site not to be missed.
- Enjoy the famous traditional **Apsara Dance** performance.
- Experience life of **Tonle Sap Floating Village**, a great natural wonder.

COMPREHENSIVE SIGHTSEEING

Cambodia Cultural Village with total area of 210,000 meter-square, represent different culture heritages and characteristics of 19 multi races.

- **Villages** There are many types of houses in Khmer village, the main model houses of Khmer people, they make their living by farming, making palm sugar, rice storage, carving, weaving, crafting farm, making clay pot, fishing and popular games.
- **Wax Museum** Cambodian Cultural Villages has two museums that exhibit the well-know persons of Cambodia, Khmer lifestyle during the Angkorian period and the breath-taking human figures with various paints.
- **Miniature** Gather all the miniatures of famous local historical buildings and structures.



Siem Reap

Located about 314 kilometers northwest of the capital (Phnom Penh), Siem Reap is home to the famed 9th to 14th century Angkor temple complex.

- **Angkor Wat** is a temple dedicated to the Hindu god Vishnu by King Suryavarman II. Angkor Wat features the longest continuous bas-relief in the world, which runs along the outer gallery walls and narrates stories from Hindu mythology. In 1992 the UNESCO declared the monument and the whole city of Angkor as a World Heritage Site.
- **Angkor Thom** was the fortified inner royal city built by Jayavarman VII; king of the Khmer Empire, at the end of the 12th century after Angkor had been conquered and destroyed by the Chams. The entire city is surrounded by a 8 meters wall. There are four gates at the center of each three kilometer long wall.
 - ✓ **Bayon** - this astonishing monument was built in the 1200's by the great Jayavarman VII and it is located in the middle of Angkor Thom city. One can witness the countless gigantic smiling faces of Avalokitesvara in this temple.
 - ✓ **Elephants Terrace** - the tall supporting wall of this terrace is sculpted with a variety of images such as an elephant procession or garudas with raised arms seemingly supporting the terrace at it corners.
 - ✓ **Leper King Terrace** is built by Jayavarman VII using the Bayon design. Found standing on the top of the platform is a sculpture of a Khmer king who is believed to have died of leprosy and this is where its name is taken from. One scene not to be missed by visitors is the carvings of seated Apsara, which are known as the dancing girls or celestial nymph, on the front retaining walls.

ITINERARY

Day 01 Depart for Siem Reap (L/D)

- Arrival Siem Reap.
- Visit to Cambodian Cultural Village; include Cambodia Traditional Wedding Function, Wax Museum, Minority Village and folk dance.
- Shop around the old market and enjoy sunset at Bakheng Hill.
- Check into hotel.

Day 02 Siem Reap (B/L/D)

- Visit the south gate of Angkor Thom featuring Bayon Temple, Ba Puon Temple, Elephant Terrace, Royal Palace and the Terrace of the Leper King.
- Excursion of Angkor Wat.
- Dinner with traditional Apsara dance performance.

Day 03 Siem Reap/Depart for home (B)

- After breakfast, explore Cambodian's floating village on the great lake of Tonle Sap.
- Visit *Les Artisan D'angkor Centre* – a handicraft centre
- Transfer to airport for returning flight, depart for home.
