目不暇給的名勝古迹!

【河內】

如今的首都河內人口近 300 萬，有綠樹成蔭的街道，碧波蕩漾、垂柳倒映的湖面，景色清又寧靜。古街與現代建築、法國式別墅建築和諧地結合，加上衆多名勝古跡和傳說故事，是河內富有思情劃意，魅力無窮。

- **胡志明陵墓：**建于 1973 年，落成于 1975 年的胡志明陵墓安放著前越南總統胡志明先生遺體供遊人凭吊，陵墓原址為 1945 年 9 月 2 日胡志明先生向國民發表越南獨立宣言之所在地。
- **一株廟：**此祠廟建在一根柱子之上，造型獨特，外型雖小，但卻是越南的代表古剎，而寺廟立在蓮花池中的優雅姿態，已成為河內的一個象徵。
- **文廟：**河內保持最好且最美的古蹟，文廟建於 1070 年李朝時代，為祭祀孔子及他的四大弟子，雖歷經千年的時間，依然保持原始的風貌。
- **36 古街：**這古色古香的傳統商店街，源自十五世紀，每一條狹窄的街道均以當時交易的商品來命名，如絲街、米街、紙街、珠寶街等，共有 36 條，並於古街內訂製一個花漾年華。

【下龍灣】

1000 多個奇特的岩石浮現在寧靜的海面上，人稱是『海上桂林』，這就是越南的一大風景名勝-下龍灣。這個地名中『Ha』是下降的意思，『Long』是龍，傳說從前受到外敵侵略，幸好有龍王之子降臨替他們解除了外患的危機，並使海上升起許多奇岩怪石，以防衛外海。深沉的海，此傳說讓這個景象，四周瀰漫著神秘的氣氛。1994 年，下龍灣被聯合國教育科學及文化組織(UNESCO)列入世界遺產。



【胡志明市】

舊稱西貢，座落於南部湄公河三角洲的西貢河畔，為越南當今第一大市。西貢原本只是一個小漁村，在法國殖民地時期，漸漸發展為商業中心，法國建造的林蔭大道、紀念旅館、市區頗具規劃性，顯見法國人曾用心經營過這個城市，全力將西貢由一個小村落推向一個繁榮的商灣。

- **百年紅教堂：**是胡志明市的代表性景點，因為外觀由紅色磚砌成的教堂，稱紅教堂，內飾雕花玻璃，莊嚴美麗。
- **統一府：**於 1868 年奠基的諾羅敦宮，原是有拱廊陽台正面的法式建築，1954 年法軍於奠邊府戰役失利後，根據日內瓦協定退出越南，此宮被移交給南越首相吳庭艷，而被改名為獨立宮。這裏也是越戰時的指揮作戰中心，1975 年坦克攻入獨立宮，南越政府就此煙消雲散，獨立也就被以統一之名取代。
- **堤岸：**胡志明市最古老的地區，唐人街亦位於此。上一個世紀中期，很多前往中國經商的人士均聚集在此，聲色享樂一番。堤岸至今仍然是華人社區的總部。
- **戰爭博物館：**是一座將越南戰爭的傷痕如實展示出來的博物館，這裡展示了觸目驚心的越戰圖片。
- **天后宮：**號稱是越南現存最老的一座廟宇，這座廟原是由廣東移民創建，後來逐漸成為西貢華人的信仰中心。

【古芝地道】

于胡志明市西北方約 70 公里處，是從第二次世界大戰後就開始挖建的地道，一直到 60 年代的越戰時期已具有相當的規模，全長 250 公里，寬約 80 公分，在這些錯綜複雜的地下通道中還有許多互相連結的地下堡壘，又有“越共總部”或“紅色首府”的稱號。

COMPREHENSIVE SIGHTSEEING

Hanoi

Located in the middle of the Red River Delta, the town has gradually expanded to become a huge population and rich residential center. May a time, Hanoi had been selected as the chief city of Vietnam under the Northern domination.

- **Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum:** Constructed between 1973 and 1975, is a glass sarcophagus set deep in the bowels of a monumental edifice that has become a site of pilgrimage.
- Hanoi's famous **One-Pillar Pagoda** was built by the Emperor Ly Thai Tong. The pagoda built of wood on a single stone pillar, 1.25m in diameter, is designed to resemble a lotus blossom symbol of purity, rising out of a sea of sorrow.
- **Temple Of Literature** was founded in 1070 by Emperor Ly Thanh Tong, who dedicated it to Confucius in order to honour scholars and men of literary accomplishment. The temple of literature is made up of five separate courtyards.
- **The 36 Ancient Street** of Hanoi's Old Quarter, bustling for more than 1000 years, makes up one of Vietnam's most lively and unusual places to visit. In the 13th century, Hanoi's artisan guilds established themselves here, each taking a different street. Today it's a shopping paradise full with merchandises from jewelry, silk to sleeping bags.



Magnificent **Halong Bay** comprises more than 3000 islands rising from the emerald waters of the Gulf Tonkin and covering an area of 1500sq km, is one of the natural marvels of Vietnam. In 1994, it was designated as Vietnam second World Heritage site.

Ho Chi Minh City (Saigon)

Ho Chi Minh is the heart and soul of Vietnam. Being the largest city, the economic capital and the cultural trendsetter of Vietnam, it is ever bustling and dynamic.

- **Notre Dame Cathedral:** Constructed between 1959 and 1962, it is an impressive modern building that combines the functional aspects of a European cathedral with traditional Vietnamese elements, including a distinctly Asian spire.
- **The Independence Palace** is one of the most fascinating sights in HCMC, both because of its striking modern and old architectures.
- **Cholon** - Ho Chi Minh City's Chinatown, is one of the oldest and most mysterious parts of HCMC. Cholon means "big market" and the best place to begin your visit is at the overwhelming Binh Tay Market.
- Visit **The War Remnant Museum** which houses instruments of torture and hundreds of photographs of atrocities committed during the Vietnam War.
- Be amazed by **Thien Hau Pagoda**, one of the most lavishly decorated pagodas in Vietnam.

Cu Chi Tunnels

The Cu Chi area of South Vietnam, stands today as a monument to the heroic struggle of the Vietnamese people and as a good example of how the people, not the technology, is the one who determines to win the war. Located approximately 36km northwest of Ho Chi Minh City, the 200km-long Cu Chi tunnels allow tourists to share underground experiences. The Viet Minh had used the tunnels for storage and shelter – it is well equipped with sleeping quarters, hospitals and schools.

Day 01 Depart for Hanoi (D)

- Upon arrival, check into hotel.
- Free at leisure.
- Enjoy Hanoi traditional Water Puppet Show.

Day 02 Hanoi / Halong Bay (B/L/D)

- Half-day city tour includes Ba Dinh Square, Ho Chi Minh's Mausoleum and Museum, One-Pillar Pagoda, Vietnamese Temple and Temple of Literature.
- Head to Halong Bay after lunch.
- Free at leisure.

Day 03 Halong Bay / Hanoi (B/L/D)

- Explore the wonderful Halong Bay by boat to Bai Tu Long Islands.
- Return to Hanoi after lunch.
- Enjoy cyclo ride along 36 ancient streets.
- Free for shopping at 36 ancient streets.

Day 04 Hanoi / Ho Chi Minh (B/L/D)

- After breakfast proceed to airport for flight to Ho Chi Minh City.
- Upon arrival, proceed for Ho Chi Minh City tour covering The Independence Palace, The War Remnant Museum Notre Dame Cathedral, Thien Hau Temple and Cholon – the city's China Town.
