## 【行程特色】

- 全程入住 4 星級酒店。

## 【暹粒-柬埔寨】

位于世界遗产吳哥窟 7 公里和洞里萨湖 12 公里处的是柬埔寨既金边以外又一主要城市暹粒。城中有一条河横穿而过。暹粒城本身并不十分繁华，以国际标准来说比较荒芜，有“酣睡的洞穴”之称。

- 吳哥古迹：大吳哥 (Angkor Thom) 大吳哥即是吳哥城，是 1181 年至 1219 年間在位的加亞華曼七世 (ayavaman VII) 所建，這是一座被長達 12 公里的護城河所包圍的大型古城。整個建築格局上，除了寬闊的護城外，還有完整的城牆、進城橋樑和五座城門。吳哥城的五座城門分別是東門、西門、南門、北門及勝利之門。
- 吳哥窟：是供奉印度神毗湿 (Vishnu) 的寺庙，为苏利亚拔摩二世所建。吳哥窟主体建筑在一个石基上，分为 3 层，约有 20 层楼高。精美浮雕长廊，刻画印度和佛教以及诸神教义的神圣色彩。于 1992 年东盟正式宣告吳哥窟为世界伟大建筑遗产之一。
- 巴戎廟：由 49 座代表當年版圖有 49 個諸侯領土，每一座 3 公尺高的塔上都刻著“四面佛陀”加亞巴爾曼七世的微笑面容，俗稱“高棉的微笑”，他以這些面孔象徵至高無上的王權，並用以反映宇宙的節奏律動，軒昂的眉宇、中穩的鼻樑、熱情的厚唇，慈祥的氣質。
- 門象台：由 54 座古塔所架構而成，周圍笑容可掬的四面神，造就聞名於世的高棉微笑；置身在迦雅巴曼七世。
- 癩王台：內有古時判官及麻瘋王雕刻建



## 【洞里萨湖】

洞里萨湖是亚洲最大的淡水湖。雨季时分，湖水比平时高涨约莫 10 倍，淹没了邻近的森林而造就肥沃的土地以供稻米的耕种。乘船游览洞里萨湖和参观柬埔寨原住民的乡村小调，绝对是一个叫人心旷神怡的体验。

## 【胡志明市】

舊稱西貢，座落於南部湄公河三角洲的西貢河畔，為越南當今第一大市。西貢原本只是一個小漁村，在法國殖民地時期，漸漸發展為商業中心，法國建造的林蔭大道、紀念旅館、市區頗具規劃性，顯見法國人曾用心經營過這個城市，全力將西貢由一個小村落推向一個繁榮的商灣。

- 百年紅教堂：是胡志明市的代表性景點，因為外觀由紅色磚砌成的教堂，稱紅教堂，內飾雕花玻璃，莊嚴美麗。
- 統一府：於 1868 年奠基的諾羅敦宮，原是有拱廊陽台正面的法式建築，1954 年法軍於奠邊府戰役失利後，根據日內瓦協定退出越南，此宮被移交給南越首領吳庭艷，而被改名為獨立宮。這裏也是越戰時的指揮作戰中心，1975 年坦克攻入獨立宮，南越政府就此煙消雲散，獨立也就被以統一之名取代。
- 堤岸：胡志明市最古老的地區，唐人街亦位於此。上一個世紀中期，很多前往中國經商的人士均聚集在此，聲色享樂一番。堤岸至今仍然是華人社區的總部。
- 戰爭博物館：是一座將越南戰爭的傷痕如實展示出來的博物館，這裡展示了觸目驚心的越戰圖片。
- 天后宮：號稱是越南現存最老的一座廟宇，這座廟原是由廣東移民創建，後來逐漸成為西貢華人的信仰中心。

## 【古芝地道】

于胡志明市西北方約 70 公里處，是從第二次世界大戰後就開始挖掘的地道，一直到 60 年代的越戰時期已具有相當的規模，全長 250 公里，寬約 80 公分，在這些錯綜複雜的地下通道中還有許多互相連結的地下堡壘，又有“越共總部”或“紅色首府”的稱號。

## COMPREHENSIVE SIGHTSEEING

### Siem Reap, Cambodia

Located about 314 kilometers northwest of the capital(Phnom Penh), Siem Reap is home to the famed 9<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> century Angkor temple complex.

- **Angkor Wat** is a temple dedicated to the Hindu god Vishnu by King Suryavarman II. Angkor Wat features the longest continuous bas-relief in the world, which runs along the outer gallery walls and narrates stories from Hindu mythology. In 1992 the UNESCO declared the monument and the whole city of Angkor as a World Heritage Site.
- **Angkor Thom** was the fortified inner royal city built by Jayavarman VII, king of the Khmer Empire, at the end of the 12<sup>th</sup> century after Angkor had been conquered and destroyed by the Chams. The entire city is surrounded by a 8 meters wall. There are four gates at the center of each three kilometer long wall.
  - ✓ **Bayon** - this astonishing monument was built in the 1200's by the great Jayavarman VII and it is located in the middle of Angkor Thom city. One can witness the countless gigantic smiling faces of Avalokitesvara in this temple.
  - ✓ **Elephants Terrace** - the tall supporting wall of this terrace is sculpted with a variety of images such as an elephant procession or garudas with raised arms seemingly supporting the terrace at its corners.
  - ✓ **Leper King Terrace** is built by Jayavarman VII using the Bayon design. Found standing on the top of the platform is a sculpture of a Khmer king who is believed to have died of leprosy and this is where its name is taken from. One scene not to be missed by visitors is the carvings of seated Apsara, which are known as the dancing girls or celestial nymph, on the front retaining walls.



Tonle Sap Lake is one of the largest freshwater lakes in Asia. During the rainy season, Tonle Sap increases its size to almost 10 times its normal size, engulfing the neighbouring forests and generating fertile silt for rice cultivation. A boat trip is highly recommended to experience the riparian life of rural Cambodians in this floating village.

### Ho Chi Minh City (Saigon)

**Ho Chi Minh** is the heart and soul of Vietnam. Being the largest city, the economic capital and the cultural trendsetter of Vietnam, is ever bustling and dynamic.

- **Notre Dame Cathedral:** Constructed between 1959 and 1962, it is an impressive modern building that combines the functional aspects of a European cathedral with traditional Vietnamese elements, including a distinctly Asian spire.
- **The Independence Palace** is one of the most fascinating sights in HCMC, both because of its striking modern architecture and the eerie feeling you will get.
- **Cholon** - Ho Chi Minh City's Chinatown, is one of the oldest and most mysterious parts of HCMC. Cholon means "big market" and the best place to begin your visit is at the overwhelming Binh Tay Market.
- Visit **The War Remnant Museum** which houses instruments of torture and hundreds of photographs of atrocities committed during the Vietnam War.
- Be amazed by **Thien Hau Pagoda**, one of the most lavishly decorated pagoda in Vietnam.

### Cu Chi Tunnels

The Cu Chi area of South Vietnam, stands today as a monument to the heroic struggle on how the people not the technology, is the one who determines to win the war. Located approximately 36km northwest of Ho Chi Minh City, the 200km-long Cu Chi tunnels allow tourists to share underground experiences. The Viet Minh had used the tunnels for storage and shelter – it is well equipped with sleeping quarters, hospitals and schools.

## ITINERARY

### Day 01 Depart for Siem Reap (D)

- Upon arrival, check into hotel.
- Free for shopping around old market.

### Day 02 Siem Reap (B/L/D)

- Angkor Wat exploration begin with visit to South Gate of Angkor Thom, Bayon, Royal Terrace, Phimeanakas, Elephant Terrace and the Terrace of the Leper King.
- Dinner with traditional Apsara dance performance.

### Day 03 Siem Reap / Ho Chi Minh City (B/L/D)

- After breakfast, explore Cambodian's floating villages at Tonle Sap by boat.
- Enroute visit Les Chantier-Ecole De Siem Reap (stone sculpture).
- Free till transfer to airport for flight to Ho Chi Minh City.
- Free for own activities.

### Day 04 Ho Chi Minh (B/L/D)

- After breakfast, proceed for Ho Chi Minh city tour covering The Independence Palace, The War Remnant Museum Notre Dame Cathedral, Thien Hau Temple and Cholon – the city's China Town.
- Enjoy Saigon River Cruise with Vietnamese traditional music & show.

### Day 05 Ho Chi Minh / Cu Chi / Ho Chi Minh (B/L/D)

- Discover the magnificent 250km Cu Chi Tunnel.
- Head back to Ho Chi Minh city, shop till drop at Ben Thanh Market.

### Day 06 Ho Chi Minh / KUL (B)

- Transfer to airport for flight back home.
